## *The Vintage*

Our exceptional run of vintages here in Oregon continues with 2018. For many reasons, a beautiful warm year can make for simply delicious Rosé. The season started on a slightly wet and cool note, leading to late bud break, but things caught up quickly. After dry weather and occasional heat spikes in July and August, the end of summer brought comfortable temperatures, a little rainfall, and the perfect set up for harvest. Our Rosé is the first expression of this terrific vintage!
