Established in 1987, Domaine Drouhin Oregon is owned by the Drouhin Family of Burgundy (Maison Joseph Drouhin). Fourth-generation winemaker Véronique Drouhin-Boss produces wines of distinction, balance, elegance and longevity. Philippe Drouhin, who oversees the family vineyards in Burgundy and Oregon, is responsible for the 225-acre estate. Today, 124 acres are under vine and are certified sustainable by L.I.V.E. The family's principled approach to viticulture and winemaking, and long experience with Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, have earned an international reputation for consistent excellence.

Véronique Drouhin-Boss

Winemaker Véronique Drouhin-Boss represents the fourth generation from this venerable wine family of France, but it is here in Oregon that Véronique's skills and passion are bringing forth some of the most sublime Pinot Noir and Chardonnay produced anywhere. Véronique has lovingly crafted every drop of wine produced at DDO since the first vintage in 1988 and is widely recognized for her experience, superb palate and joyful approach to wine and life. These qualities are easily recognizable in her wines.

Arron Bell is our Assistant Winemaker, in Charge of all winemaking operations under Véronique's direction. After moving back to Oregon in 2002, Arron was hired as caviste and was eventually promoted through the ranks to Hospitality Director, Cellarmaster and in 2009 as DDO's first Assistant Winemaker. Today he works hand in hand with Véronique to produce the elegant, age-worthy wines for which DDO is known.
